### I. The Need to \_\_\_\_\_ (vs. 11-14)

- A. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Hypocrisy (vs. 11-12)  
“Withdrew” - a military term meaning retreat or disengage.
- B. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Hypocrisy (v. 13)  
A legalist is almost always more concerned for laws than for lives.
- C. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Hypocrisy (v. 14)  
The difference between principles, preferences, and prejudices.

### II. The Need to \_\_\_\_\_ (vs. 15-18)

- A. The Reality of a \_\_\_\_\_ Life (vs. 15-16)  
“No one” can measure up.
- B. The Responsibility of a \_\_\_\_\_ Life (v. 17)  
“I have a growing desire to know God.” - Steve McVey
- C. The Return to a \_\_\_\_\_ Life (v. 18)  
“Don’t submit again to a yoke of slavery.” - Gal. 5:1

### III. The Need to \_\_\_\_\_ (vs. 19-21)

- A. I am \_\_\_\_\_ of Guilt (v. 19a)

- B. I am \_\_\_\_\_ to God (vs. 19b-20)  
I have a new spirit!

I am valuable!
